Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) connects consumers directly with local farms. CSA subscribers sign up to receive boxes of just-picked, organic and pesticide-free, seasonal produce from farmers. Boxes are delivered to homes and offices or picked up from central urban locations. CSA customers help protect small farmers from the competition of large-scale agriculture, fluctuations of wholesale markets, and damaging weather.
